## BDI (Bangladesh Development Initiative) Solemanpur/Kotchandpur Fund:

On January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, this fund established five scholarships to be given to five poor meritorious Kotchandpur high school students listed below (Kotchandpur Upozila (sub-division) is within Jhinaidah Zilla (district) of Bangladesh). Individual scholarship is named after the donor of the original fund. Each scholarship recipient of the fund was awarded with 5000 (five thousand) Bangladeshi taka upfront on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012 in a formal ceremony. A five-lakh (500000) taka Sonchoy Potro, whose proceeds can be cashed every three months, was bought from Bangladesh National Savings Bureau to make this award permanent. The proceeds earned from this Sonchoy Potro will be used to give 10000 (ten thousand) taka annually to each of these students till they complete Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination. The scholarship recipients must maintain results above certain levels, to be determined by the Kotchandpur high school committee, for continued eligibility as scholarship recipients. When current scholarship recipients successfully complete SSC examination, a batch of new students from class 6 and/or seven will be selected as the next scholarship recipients.
